JUNIOR CODE OF CONDUCT

All Junior Members are asked to abide by the following rules at all times.

They should:

Co-operate fully, respecting all requests and decisions made by the coaches, helpers, officials and administrators.

Control their tempers and avoid antisocial behaviour, which may inconvenience or upset others.

Be considerate and respectful to other paddlers and water users - treat other paddlers as they would want to be treated.

Wear suitable clothing and kit for paddling as agreed with coaches and Club officials.

Take care of all property belonging to the Club or any Club member - and be responsible for caring for their own equipment and clothing.

Not leave sessions without the permission of the coach or leader and until collected by a parent, guardian or nominated adult.

Not consume alcohol or non-prescribed drugs of any kind whilst on Club premises, trips or representing the club at events.

Be on time for training sessions and events. Inform the coach or session leader if expected to be late or are unable to attend.
